FACTS ABOUT THE 2010 ELECTION

Offices to be Elected:

Mayor (two year term)
Member of the City Council (four year term)
City Clerk (four year term)

Dates to Remember:

March 15, 2010	Ballots to be mailed to voters registered as permanent vote by mail voters
March 15 to April 6, 2010	Applications accepted to vote by mail for this election only
March 23, 2010	Sample ballot/voter information pamphlets must be mailed to registered voters no later than this date
March 29, 2010	Last day to register to vote for this election
April 6 to 12, 2010	Emergency vote by mail period – voters may cast ballots in person at City Hall if unable to vote at the polling place on election day

Polling Places:

To find your polling place, look on the back cover of your sample ballot/voter information pamphlet.

On election day, the polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m.

Election Results:

Ballots received from the polling places and most vote-by-mail ballots will be counted in the council chamber at City Hall on election night. These preliminary results will be posted on the City's website. The final results of the election must be declared by the City Council in a meeting to be held no later than Friday, May 7, 2010. At the same meeting, the newly elected officials will be sworn into office and the City Council will select one of its members as the mayor pro tem.
