NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
33RD PROGRAM YEAR - CDBG

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lawndale City Council will hold a public hearing on **Monday, December 18, 2006 at 6:30 p.m.** in the Council Chambers of the Lawndale City Hall, 14717 Burin Avenue, Lawndale, California 90260. The Council will receive testimony relative to the following project:

PROJECT SELECTION FOR THE 2007-08 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM YEAR. The City of Lawndale is soliciting public input to consider the expenditure of funds to be received as a result of the 1974 Housing and Community Development Act. The public is encouraged to attend and suggest needs and priorities for possible funding during the 2007-08 (33rd) program year beginning July 1, 2007. Initial estimates are that Lawndale will be allocated approximately \$453,523 in program funds for this Program Year. These are restricted funds to be used to assist low- and moderate-income persons, or to remove slum and blight conditions. A maximum of 15% of the annual allocation may be used for public service projects. A draft program will be presented for the City Council to consider. Current programs include: Administration, Senior Nutrition, Graffiti Removal, Residential Rehabilitation, Street Improvements, and Sidewalk Improvements.

Those wishing to comment on this item may do so in person at the public hearing, or by submitting written comments by 5:00 p.m. on the date of the aforementioned hearing.
