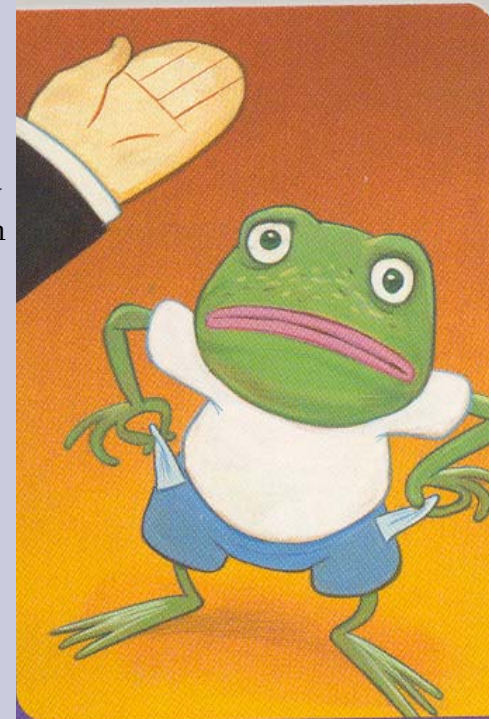
CompoBus Debut—Metro recently introduced a new lightweight 45-foot bus to the public. The vehicle can carry 16 percent more passengers than conventional buses and is the first of 100 CompoBuses expected to be in service by June 2005.
