Safety Begins With Me : Metro Bus Safety—Use handrails when boarding. Metro Rail Safety—Don't cross tracks until you can see all tracks clearly.

Line 205, 447 and 550 Changes in San Pedro—Starting October 24 route modifications will remove buses from Averill Avenue between 7th and 9th Streets and affect eastbound service on 7th and 13th Streets. The southern terminal for Line 205 will move from 8th/Averill to 13th/Gaffey. Line 205 will provide eastbound service on 7th Street (previously provided by Lines 447 and 550).
