

**RESOLUTION NO. CC-9804-28**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
LAWNDALE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE  
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 14, 1998,  
DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS  
AS PROVIDED BY LAW.**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Lawndale, California, on Tuesday, April 14, 1998, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. CC-9711-101, adopted November 17, 1997, the City Clerk canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWNDALE, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City, except absent voter and provisional ballots was 1057.

That the whole number of ballots cast in the City (including absent voter and provisional ballots) was 1479.

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Mayor - Two Year Term are as follows:

HAROLD E. HOFMANN  
NANCY J. MARTHENS

That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council - Four Year Term are as follows:

M. MEHRDAD NOURAYI  
CAROL NORMAN  
VIRGINIA M. RHODES

That the names of persons voted for at the election for City Clerk - Four Year Term are as follows:

UFFE M. MOLLER  
STEPHEN NICOLOPULOS

That the measure voted upon at the election is as follows:

SHALL THE LAWNDALE CITY COUNCIL AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY BE AUTHORIZED TO EXPEND UP TO \$15 MILLION FROM SOURCES SUCH AS THE URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACTION GRANT ("UDAG") ACCOUNT(S) OR REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY BONDING, BUT NOT INCLUDING THE GENERAL FUND, FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTING THE HAWTHORNE BOULEVARD REVITALIZATION PROJECT?

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above-named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates are as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that: Harold E. Hofmann was elected as Mayor for the full term of two years; Larry Rudolph was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Virginia M. Rhodes was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Stephen Nicolopulos was elected as City Clerk for the full term of four years.

That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on the measure relating to the Hawthorne Boulevard Revitalization Project did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the result of the election showing: (1) the whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) the measure voted on; (4) for what office each person was voted; (5) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and (6) the total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Attorney shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

**Subject:** CERTIFICATION OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

**Summary:** The General Municipal Election for the City of Lawndale was held on Tuesday, April 14, 1998, for the purpose of electing a mayor and two members of the city council and a city clerk. On the same ballot, a measure regarding the Hawthorne Boulevard Revitalization Project was submitted to the voters.

There were two candidates for the office of Mayor: Harold E. Hofmann and Nancy J. Marthens, and Harold E. Hofmann was elected for a two-year term.

There were four candidates for the City Council: M. Mehrdad Nourayi, Carol Norman, Virginia M. Rhodes and Larry Rudolph, and Virginia M. Rhodes and Larry Rudolph were elected, each for a four-year term.

There were two candidates for the office of City Clerk: Stephen Nicolopoulos and Uffe H. Moller, and Stephen Nicolopoulos was elected for a four-year term.

The measure regarding the Hawthorne Boulevard Revitalization Project was approved.

The returns of the election have been canvassed by the City Clerk staff, and a resolution prepared certifying the statement of the vote of the electorate.

**Recommended Action** THEREFORE, STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT the Council adopt Resolution No. CC-9804-28 reciting the fact of the General Municipal Election, declaring the result and such other matters as provided by law.
