

RESOLUTION NO. CC-9711-106

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF LAWNDALE,  
CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF  
THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 1997, DECLARING  
THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER  
MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Lawndale, California, on Tuesday, November 4, 1997, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. CC-9705-42, adopted May 12, 1997, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWNDALE, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City, except absent voter and provisional ballots was 1,030.

That the whole number of ballots cast in the City (including absent voter and provisional ballots) was 1,355.

SECTION 2. That the measures voted for at the election are as follows:

- N. Shall Ordinance No. 822-97 be adopted changing the office of City Clerk from elective to appointive?
- O. Shall the term of office of Mayor be two years?
- P. Shall the term of office of Mayor be four years?

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the above measures are as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure N relating to the office of City Clerk did not vote in favor of it, and that the measure was not carried, and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 5. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure O relating to the office of Mayor did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 6. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure P relating to the office of Mayor did not vote in favor of it, and that the measure was not carried, and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the result of the election showing: (1) the whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the measures voted on; (3) the number of votes given at each precinct to each measure; and (4) the total number of votes given to each measure.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
