## A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

### F. ITEMS FROM COMMUNITY SERVICES STAFF

# 1. Potential Expenditure, Senior Tea Party Sponsorship for 2020-21:

Director Estes summarized the attached staff report and verified funds are available for the expense being considered per PRSSC Resolution 1984-20.

## 2. PRSSC Fireworks Stand Fundraising Program:

Director Estes reported the following to the PRSSC: 1) there were five entities, not including the PRSSC, that were granted sales permits at the February 18th, City Council meeting; 2) the course of action determined by the PRSSC at a recent meeting was to distribute a Request for Proposal (RFP) to both licensed pyrotechnic vendors; 3) there were more details to confirm with the Centinela Valley Union High School District before the RFP is to be distributed; and 4) it is being anticipated that the RFP can be released within the next few weeks.

There were other discussions about the RFP process.

# 3. Lawndale Municipal Code, Chapter 3.10, Purchasing by the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission and Chapter 8.12, Fireworks:

Director Estes introduced this item as one that could help all parties get on the same page as it pertains to eligible expenses and processes involved in purchasing by the PRSSC and reviewed the following Lawndale Municipal Code items:

- Purchasing by the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission, Chapter 3.10.020
- Purchasing by the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission, Chapter 3.10.030
- Fireworks, Chapter 8.12

Director Estes also discussed some of the history as it pertains to other commissions that have been involved in the use of PRSSC Fireworks Trust Funds account monies in the past.

## 6. Easter Egg Hunt, Saturday, April 11th, 2020

Director Estes reported the following to the PRSSC as it pertains to the Golden Egg award as it relates to the discussions by the PRRSC at a previous meeting. The issue was discussed by the Youth Advisory Committee at a recent meeting and a few suggestions were offered. Director Estes informed the PRSSC that he will provide a more comprehensive report at the PRSSC's next regularly scheduled meeting. There was also discussion about the supply of eggs being purchased for the Egg Hunt on April 11<sup>th</sup>.

## 7. Youth Day Parade Planning Update:

Director Estes reported the following to the PRSSC regarding the planning process for the Youth Day Parade: 1) the committee met tonight and a lot of ground was covered; 2) the number of entries will substantially increase as many more applications have been received, but not entered onto the official entry list; 3) the school district will be adding a game truck to the event activity area which will be paid for by the school district; 4) there were discussions about the spring extravaganza portion of the event as well; and 5) trophy samples were reviewed and selections were made; however, trophies cannot be ordered until we get to the deadline when we will ultimately know how many entries we will have.

One commissioner discussed information provided by the school district as it pertains to Census 2020. Director Estes commented that the City has been communicating with the school district for use of facilities for training and census completion activities.
