F. ADMINSTRATION

- 1. Youth Day Parade update Staff asked for an update on committee participation for the parade on April 27, 2019. Committee members April, Anyelin and Kaleb were noted as a "maybe" and Committee members Katie and Soraya were unable to participate since they are walking as an entry group in the parade with their respective schools. Staff let the members know that if they wanted to participate as a committee entry they could walk or ride their bicycles.
- 2. Easter Egg Hunt update Staff gave the committee an update on the Easter Egg Hunt activities which included arts & crafts and visits with the Easter bunny. A new idea being proposed this year was chalk art. Several committee members said that Jane Addams Park holds an event called Bengal Bowl at the end of the year

where students are able to participate in chalk art activities so they liked the idea of bringing art to the Easter Egg Hunt event for kids. Staff reminded the committee that if they wanted to volunteer at the event they should arrive before 10 a.m. so they could get situated at their post.

- **3. Historical Museum volunteer hours** Staff asked the committee members to commit to volunteering at the Historical Museum. Several members said they had busy schedules and Spring Break was taking place the following week so they were not available. Staff reminded the committee that this was an important task and encouraged them to sign-up for hours with the City Historian.
- **4. New Rec Coordinator** Staff announced that the city hired a new Recreation Coordinator and his first day would be April 15th. The new Recreation Coordinator will be involved in youth and teen programs and will work with staff and the Youth Advisory Committee on events and activities throughout the year.
