- 1. Introduction of new Recreation Coordinator Staff introduced the new Recreation Coordinator, Anthony Lemonds, to the committee. He told them a little bit about his background and said he was looking forward to working with teens on new programs and events. Each committee member went around the room and introduced themselves and gave a brief history of their service on YAC.
- **2. Summer Movie Night selection** –Staff informed the committee that the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission generously donated \$1,000 for three Summer Movie Nights. The committee discussed summer dates and voted on the movie selection. The schedule is as follows:
 - Friday, June 28th: Shrek
 - Friday, July 26th: Lion King
 - Friday, August 23rd: Spiderman: Into the Spider Verse

The committee discussed purchasing snacks for the public such as cookies, sodas and popcorn. They also discussed purchasing bean bag chairs and mats for people to sit on inside the Community Center. There was a brief discussion on the location of the movie nights, either the Community Center or Rudolph Park. Committee member Owens was in favor of the Community Center since it was indoors and the weather would not affect attendance. Committee member Kaleb said that balloons and signs outside the venue would help attract the public so the members voted in favor of the Community Center as the location 5-0.

3. Historical Museum volunteer hours – The committee members gave an update on their volunteer hours at the museum. Committee member Katie said she volunteered with her friend and completed 3-5 hours. She was also signed up to volunteer the following week. Staff encouraged the other members to take turns and volunteer on a weekly basis.
