# A. <u>CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL</u>

#### F. <u>ITEMS FROM COMMUNITY SERVICES STAFF</u>

#### 1. Potential Expenditure, Giveaway Items for Halloween Haunt Special Event

Director Estes summarized the attached staff report for Resolution 1088-21 pertaining to the purchase of a Halloween giveaway item for children at the 2021 Halloween Haunt special event. Prior to the motion to approve, Commissioner Lin requested clarification concerning leftover supplies, distribution and/or proper storage of the items to be used at a later date. After a number of discussions, Commissioner Martinez motioned to approve PRSSC Resolution 1088-21, seconded by Commissioner Lin. Motion carries 3-0, 2 Commissioners absent.

#### 2. Potential Expenditure, Donation to City for 2021 Holiday Decorations Program

Director Estes summarized the attached staff report for PRSSC Resolution 1089-21 and provided a summary of prior PRSSC purchases for the City Holiday Decorations program. Upon completion of the full reading and further discussions by the PRSSC, Chairperson Carroll motioned to approve, seconded by Commissioner Martinez. Motion carries 2-0-1, 2 commissioners absent.

### 3. PRSSC Street Pole Banner Project, Spring Designs Review

Director Estes informed the PRSSC that the Winter/Holiday street pole banners were due to be delivered to the City next week. Six Spring banner designs were presented for review, along with various color swatches to aide in color discussions and other banner draft revisions being made to the existing layouts. Present members of the commission expressed their favorite banners with minimal revisions but opted to halt further decision-making and discussion until ta full commission is present. Revisions and the finalization of the Spring banners will resume at the PRSSC's next regularly scheduled meeting on October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

# 4. PRSSC Fireworks Trust Fund Account, Master Funding Expense Plan

Commission Lin elaborated on his vision for a PRSSC Master Funding Plan by suggesting the development of guidelines and principles that would implement a spending and fundraising threshold. Some of the goals of the plan would be to bring more visibility to the South Bay through PRSSC collaborations and partnerships with the Lawndale businesses community. The collaboration could lead to heightened exposure on multiple social media platforms and increased awareness and attendance at PRSSC funded events.

# 5. 2021 Halloween Haunt Event Update, Saturday, October 30th, 2021, 4:00 p.m.

Director Estes reported to the PRSSC that the 2021 Halloween Haunt event is on target to proceed as an outdoor event on Saturday, October 30<sup>th</sup> beginning at 4:00 p.m. Event activities will include the following: 1) a trick-or-treat trail; 2) costume contests for four separate age divisions; 3) a disc jockey for music and public address purposes; 4) stage entertainment such as a puppet show on the Show Wagon Mobile Trailer; and 5) a City Council and Special Guests welcome.

The PRSSC's giveaway item, Glow-in-the Dark necklaces, have been received. The number of Lawndale area businesses being recruited to participate in the Trick-or-Treat Trail is lower than expected, but the Community Services Department is optimistic things will pick up in the next few weeks. As well, food vendors are still being recruited. The opportunity for the Leuzinger High School Cooking/Kitchen program to participate in the event as a food vendor is being discussed as well.

Advertising for the Halloween Haunt program will continue to run via the City website, social media pages, flyers, and the electronic sign adjacent to the 405 freeway southbound lanes.
